ELECTRIC SUPPLY CHAIN CRISIS

The supply chain crisis in America poses a threat to the short-term reliability of America's electric grid.

THESE THREATS COME FROM:

- Lack of domestic production of raw materials
- Reduction in overseas production and manufacturing
- Unreliable international shipping
- Labor market shortages

THE IMPACT HAS LED TO EXPONENTIAL AND UNBEARABLE INCREASES IN:

- Material costs
- Shipping costs
- Lead/order times
- Delivery times

Necessary infrastructure supplies may be unavailable to distribution utilities in the event of a large-scale natural disaster or even for growth in the residential and commercial development markets. Many utilities have moved into preservation mode, rather than growth mode, and halted capital investments due to uncertainty future supply availability. This hurts the economy as contracted construction crews are furloughed. CARES is raising the profile of the electric supply chain crisis to find solutions that ensure grid reliability.
